Weather in the spring and summer of 2021 produced a small crop of tiny, flavorful berries. Then a long, cool ripening season brought the fruit to balanced deliciousness with wildly complex flavors.

This Cabernet Franc delights with a wonderful tension between power and elegance. Robust cherry flavors play with green olive, notes of bay leaf, fresh mint and *Herbes de Provence*, with white pepper notes chiming in. A graceful floral perfume of peonies and violets tops it off.

notes, and the lightest touch of chocolate mint. The tannins are fine grained and abundant enough to drink now alongside a meal or hold in cellar for aging.

94 Cathy Corison's 2021 Cabernet Franc bottling from the Sunbasket Vineyard is outstanding. It comes in at a well-measured 13.9 percent puguet of cassis, sweet dark berries, menthol, cigar wrapper, dark soil

octane and delivers a vibrant and utterly refined bouquet of cassis, sweet dark berries, menthol, cigar wrapper, dark soil tones, a very elegant framing of new oak and a smoky topnote. On the palate the wine is bright, focused and full-bodied, with a sappy core of fruit, lovely soil inflection, ripe, buried tannins and a long, bouncy and complex finish.

Medium to dark garnet in the glass, this wine smells of cherry, crushed nuts, and violets. In the mouth, cherry and floral flavors are wrapped in a muscular sheaf of tannins that squeezes the palate even as juicy black plum and cherry notes linger in the finish. Excellent acidity.
